Common Interview Questions

Below are a few examples of common interview questions you may come across. These questions are broken into two parts: Experience Based Questions and Situational Questions. For the Situational Based Questions, you can answer these using the STAR Method (see STAR Method resource for more details).

Experience Based Questions:

- 1. Tell me about yourself
- 2. Why do you want to work for this company?
- 3. Why are you a good fit for this position?
- 4. Why is this position a good fit for you?
- 5. What motivates you?
- 6. Why should we hire you?
- 7. What do you know about our company?
- 8. How do you prioritize your workload?
- 9. What are your biggest strengths?
- 10. What's your biggest weakness?

Situational Based Questions:

- 1. Tell me about a time you went above and beyond
- 2. Tell me about a time you had to deal with a difficult customer or client?
- 3. Describe a situation where you had to take charge of a project or initiative. How did you manage it?
- 4. How do you prioritize your work when you have multiple high priority task to accomplish?
- 5. Describe a situation where you discovered a problem and took steps to fix it
- 6. What accomplishments in your career are you most proud of? How did you achieve it?
- 7. Tell me about a situation where your integrity was challenged
- 8. Tell me about a time you worked on a team to accomplish a project.
- 9. Tell me about a time you failed. How did you learn from this experience?
- 10. How do you schedule your day to ensure you meet your deadlines?
